In order to have the friends at home and abroad receive an enhanced understanding of rich and multiple collection at the NCL, there was a series of activity with the topic centered on “An Elegant Person in Thousand Years,” which include professor Hsin-hsiung Chen of National Taiwan Normal University who wrote an introduction to reading that covers the selected collection of classic rare books and stone rubbing copies.

The period of creative writing of Su Tong-po covers 12th century to 1870s, i.e., from the early South Song Dynasty to the late Qing Dynasty. Five subjects include Thinking about Tong-po from

distance, explore his world of emotion, Tong-po world of literature, Tong-po life of arts, and Tong-po’s wave of thoughts.

NCL authored a new books searched for the related writings of “Four Treasuries of Books” completed in Chin Dynasty, with a purpose of re-description and re-discussion from among its more than 12,900 sets and more than 135,000 volumes of classic rare books. Based on its nature and the sequence of completion of the “Four Treasuries of Books,” this new book contains five categories as follows: the first is “memos of representatives in provinces,” the second is “basic volumes of Four Treasuries of Books,” the third is “Original Volumes or Preliminary Writing of Four Treasuries of Books,” the fourth is “Wen Lan Ko version of Four Treasuries of Books,” and the fifth is “manuscript version of Four Treasuries of Books. Also, there are the short descriptions for each category.
