international Sinologists may get to better know the achievements of Taiwan Chinese Studies research and the current publishing situation thereby strengthening academic cooperation and exchanges.

Besides allowing scholars from around the world to browse through the books and materials exhibited and make orders as well, after the conference, the books exhibited were donated to the University of Washington and the University of Oregon to enrich their respective library collections, providing local researchers with related resource materials.


