### ■ Taiwan Most Influential Academic Resources Award Ceremony and Press Conference

On March 31, 2017, NCL held a Taiwan Most Influential Academic Resources Award Ceremony and Press Conference. Results were gathered using metadata from three main systems at NCL: the National Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations in Taiwan, the Taiwan Citation Index—Humanities and Social Sciences, and the Index to Taiwan Periodical Literature System. Most influential academic resources, universities and colleagues were concluded from the data. A report was presented and awards were given accordingly.

The eight awards issued included the Most Influential Humanities and Social Science

Journal, the Most Read Academic Journal, the Most Downloaded Academic Journal, the Best Academic Repository, the Best Academic Dissemination, the Best Academic Visibility, the Knowledge Sharing Award, and the Academic Influence Award. A total of 113 academic journal publishers, universities and colleges attended. NCL also took this advantage to thank these organizations for their support and authorization to use their publications.
