News from Taiwan Libraries

■ Pingtung County Government Renovates Its Main Library

To provide a better reading space, the Pingtung (屏東) County government is renovating its main library. The main building will incorporate indigenous totems, and establish special children's, teenage, senior citizen, multicultural, and Pingtung literature areas. The estimated completion date is October 2018

■ Taichung to Build Taiwan's First National Manga Museum

On October 28, 2017, Taiwan's Minister of Culture and Taichung (台中) City signed a MOU of cooperation. Their plan is to establish a National Manga Museum in the city by 2020. It will combine the use of new technologies such as augmented reality (AR) and virtual reality (VR), and will partner with the Taichung branch of the Taiwan

Film Institute to promote the development of Taiwanese manga.

■ A Former Military Village Is Transformed into a New Kind of Library in Hsinchu City

Jincheng (金城) New Village, formerly home to dependents of military personnel, is being transformed into General Village Open Library and Information Area in Hsinchu (新竹) city.

There will be lots of theme pavilions set up in the area such as living, slow eating, military village culture, and the restoration of artifacts. An earth library combining a small farmer's market and edible landscaping is planned for the outside space. The library's innovative conceptual design will create a new venue for knowledge learning. Work is scheduled for completion in October 2018.
