countries of the foreign scholars, and executive director of the Fulbright Scholar Program Dr. William C. Vocke attended this event. In all, there were close to one hundred people in attendance.

MOFA's Taiwan Fellowship began in 2010 to encourage outstanding experts and scholars abroad to come and conduct research in Taiwan's universities and research institutes for a period of three months to a year. It was hoped that doing so would stimulate scholarly exchange and collaboration between scholars in Taiwan and abroad. As of this year, a total of 934 scholars from 78 countries have come to Taiwan for research. This has increased Taiwan's visibility in the international community, as well as furthered the link between research institutes in Taiwan and the international community at large.

■ Taoyuan Public Library Longtan Branch and Teng Yu-hsien Taiwanese Music **Memorial Hall Open**

On November 6, 2018, the opening ceremony took place for the Taoyuan Public Library Longtan Branch and Teng Yu-hsien Taiwanese Music Memorial Hall. The library combines music, audio-visual, reading, study, and exhibition functions, while also offering visitors views of the surrounding landscape. This intelligent, completely digital library and small-scale cultural center also houses the Teng Yu-hsien Taiwanese Music Memorial Hall, which maintains a collection of historical materials associated with Taiwanese music and the life and music of the father of Taiwanese folk song, Teng Yu-hsien. The music museum includes old musical instruments, vinyl records, and gramophones, while also offering visitors a Virtual Reality experience. The landscaped design of the library provides visitors with views of the surrounding landscape, helping to win it the Chinese Architectural Golden Stone Award and the FIABCI-Taiwan Prix d'Excellence Award. It is fast becoming one of Longtan's important cultural landmarks.
