CCS's Visiting Scholars Attend the 2018 R.O.C. National Day Reception

The 2018 R.O.C. National Day Reception was held at the Taipei Guest House on October 10, as is customary. The National Central Library (NCL) made special arrangements to have CCS's recipients of the Research Grant for Foreign Scholars in Chinese Studies, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' recipients of the Taiwan Fellowship and their spouses to attend. 2018 Farewell Party for Taiwan Fellowship

The National Central Library (NCL) has been tasked by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) to carry out the Taiwan Fellowship project. On December 17, 2018, MOFA held a farewell party for foreign scholars currently in Taiwan on the research fellowship. Viceminister of Foreign Affairs Li-jie Tsao spoke at the event. The NCL Director-General Shuhsien Tseng, and fellowship recipients in Taiwan and their family members, ambassadors and representatives to Taiwan from the host countries of the foreign scholars, and executive director of the Fulbright Scholar Program Dr. William C. Vocke attended this event. In all, there were close to one hundred people in attendance.

MOFA's Taiwan Fellowship began in 2010 to encourage outstanding experts and scholars abroad to come and conduct research in Taiwan's universities and research institutes for a period of three months to a year. It was hoped that doing so would stimulate scholarly exchange and collaboration between scholars in Taiwan and abroad. As of this year, a total of 934 scholars from 78 countries have come to Taiwan for research. This has increased Taiwan's visibility in the international community, as well as furthered the link between research institutes in Taiwan and the international community at large.
