

NCL Announcement in respond to the 2019 novel coronavirus

As the recent cumulative total of confirmed cases of 2019 novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV) infection in China is rapidly growing, the Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) announced the following instruction:

Taiwanese nationals	Starting from 0:00 am of February 6, 2020, whoever visited mainland China, Hong Kong and Macao should stay at home for a 14-day self quarantining and keep self health check.
PRC nationals	Chinese residents to be prohibited from entering Taiwan.
Hong Kong and Macau residents	Starting from February 7, they are required to be under home quarantine for 14 days after entering Taiwan. starting from February 7, foreign nationals who have visited or resided in China, Hong Kong and Macau in the previous 14 days are temporarily from entering Taiwan.
Foreign nationals	Starting from February 7, foreign nationals who have visited or resided in China, Hong Kong and Macau in the previous 14 days are temporarily from entering Taiwan.

Starting from 0:00 am of February 10, 2020, travelers who transit through China, Hong Kong and Macau and are granted entry into Taiwan and will be required to be under home quarantine for 14 days.

The abovementioned measures will be adjusted according to epidemic situation.

For public health safety, please don't visit the NCL during your self-quarantine. In addition, stay home during most of your self-quarantine time.
