The robust and complete catalog of a library is the basis of its reader services. Of these, authority file and bibliographic searches are a critical way for readers to search for publication information. In the last ten years, libraries worldwide have experienced rapid growth related with linked data. This has caused the library and information communities in Taiwan to consider about how to apply the concept of linked data and associated technology to enable data linking for Chinese library resources. Given the importance of linked data in terms of future library services, it is hoped that this book can, in a clear and easy-to-understand manner, help librarians in Taiwan understand the basic concepts and principles of linked data, the current development status of linked data in library and information science, standards and information application of linked data, methods of converting library catalog and authority files into linked data and related import methods, operation rules and examples for linked data processing, and future development and application of linked data in Taiwan's library and information science discipline.
