number of distinctive bookmarks made by collectors, including bookmarks made from used train tickets, clothing accessories, scraps of cloth and cellphone accessories.

The NTL regularly organizes art and craft exhibitions to enhance the library's aesthetic environment. The bookmark exhibition also turned the highlight on an object that represents a pause in reading and provides inspiration for thought both in their designs and the words of wisdom they bear.
