from the later part of the Japanese occupation period to the early post-war period. The online resources, in turn, are arranged in the categories of general resources, philosophy and religion, science, health and agriculture, social sciences, historical figures, language and literature, and the arts.

Luzhou City Opens First Children's Library

The Luzhou City Children's Library in Taipei County officially opened on August 9. The first library of its kind in Luzhou, the new facility is stocked with 30,000 books. The library has an open stack area, comic area, newspaper and periodical area, family book area, toy area, audio-visual area, and internet area. The local village chief plans to introduce a storytelling program staffed by volunteer moms to encourage children in the community to read.

Joyful October Book Exhibition

A book exhibition and related activities were held on September 25 to October 7 at Chiang Kaishek Memorial Hall as a warm-up to the ROC National Day. The exhibition was included several theme book areas, and coupons for book discounts were distributed to the public. Family classes were arranged, as well, including classes on book cover making, and children's finger songs. A family seminar and book signing were also held for the public.

■ NTL Holds Flora Expo Book Exhibition

In conjunction with the upcoming 2010 Taipei International Flora Exposition, the National Taiwan Library arranged a book exhibition with titles introducing flowers, gardening skills, green living and other floral and environmental themes.

■ 2010 Public Library Book & Bike, Read & Ride Activity

Launched by National Taichung Library, this activity brought together unique public libraries in



eight counties and cities of central Taiwan. Twenty cycling routes were planned, joining cultural and natural attractions under a reading-related theme. The activity will be held from October 5 to December.

■ Multiculturalism in Southeast Asia: Vietnam, Indonesia, Thailand and Myanmar

In order to meet the study and recreation needs of the growing community of foreign residents in Taiwan, the National Taiwan Library opened a "Multicultural Resource Area" this November. The area is stocked with books in Vietnamese. Indonesian, Thai, and Burmese. The library also teamed up with Dafeng Elementary School, Jisui Elementary School, the Pearl S. Buck Foundation. Taipei, ROC-Myanmar Cultural Exchange Association, Museum of World Religious, and Shulin Elementary School to hold a "Southeast Asia Multicultural Exhibition" from October 19. The exhibition highlighted Thai, Indonesian, Vietnamese, and Burmese culture, and new immigrants to Taiwan from these areas in order to heighten sensitivity to and acceptance of different cultures.
